



Report of meeting held at School of Economic Science, 11 Mandeville Place, London W1U 3AJ
Notes of Open Research Group meeting on 23rd August 2017: [OpenResearchGroup-170823](#)
Present: Janos, Ahmet, William Bort, Mary (notes), Ellena.

Mary reported on promotional work she was doing for a conference on **Saturday 7th October 2017** with an umbrella title: "Expanding a Humanistic Vision for a 21st Century Psychology". Themes include psychology and activism, future self as living entity, expanding the humanistic paradigm for the 21st-century context, Humanistic Psychology 'outside the box', and visioning our humanistic future – a rich mixture of the "self" and "society" dialectic that are at the core of Humanistic Psychology as a genuinely progressive psychology for the current era. William Bort, whom Janos originally met at Speakers Corner, spoke about the importance of the family as a basis for society. He has a prophetic ability inherited from his mother and also told us that a particular star formation not happened since 7k years - a prophecy in the book of revelation - is coming through on 23rd September, which is an alignment - it has also been predicted by the solarium software: <http://earthsky.org/human-world/biblical-signs-in-the-sky-september-23-2017>

Ahmet Altun – his background is in radiology, and he has developed a purpose to promote the truth of society's problem, feels that basis of life is faith and poetical background. After qualifying in medicine he became aware of many contradictions, such as the fact that modern medicine exploits the body for the sake of the market, and that globally people believe in modern medicine unconditionally. He studied coal-mining, and the effects on the body of being 200m under the surface. The evidence supported his ideas about the body, which is that it's a modeling system with a mechanical frame, but we need different ideas from philosophy and art to understand it. He turned to social science and philosophy, Grotolsky and Brett as well as Michel Foucault, a French philosopher, to learned about performance, and their concepts about the body, and its relationship to food, art, and other things. The "dialectical body" means it's a dynamic unit, responding to its environment and its own desires. Desire shapes the body and creates positive signals and secretions, as well as negative signals leading to disease, eg cancer. Ahmet has presented his ideas in many TV channels, has written many articles, in Turkish – he came to London only 5 months ago (see notes from last week). He found the phrase "something new much emerge" on the meet-up platform, which was his breakthrough. **Janos** had taken this phrase from Adidam (Da Free John), who wrote "Not-Two is Peace" - The Ordinary People's Way of Global Cooperative Order, By the World-Friend ADI DA – ie division creates problems: <http://www.da-peace.org>

Ellena said she is here because of Occupy – when the banks crashed in 2008, she realised that the anti-capitalists were right, and eventually on October 15th 2011 joined Occupy – "something is emerging". She was on the train to Hull and when she arrived saw it on the TV, and realised it was real. There was also another protest, a gypsy camp (where they were evicted), they were all still here when she arrived back in London. She came for the economy lectures, commuted rather than camping, found the knowledge there and decided to follow it – also the Occupy Economics Working Group: <http://occupylondon.org.uk/45300-2/occupy-economics-working-group/> - which still meets.

DISCUSSION: on Emergence and End Times

Ellena had in the past found her way to Findhorn Community in Scotland – <https://www.findhorn.org>. She used to go for week-long experiences, how it happened was very interesting, there were criticisms of it as being too “American”, but it introduced her to group work on Psychosynthesis and Sacred Dance. The first time she went, things happened in the group that her feel uncomfortable, but she had confidence in the trainers, and usually by the Wednesday the group has got to know each other and issues that need working on come out. At one time she was a regular attendee at Lower Shaw Farm, but also used to go up to Findhorn three times a year.

We recalled the history of Findhorn which was founded by Eileen Caddy and Peter, he was in the military, there was an air base at Kinloss, a car park and hotel. Peter had been the manager of a hotel near the train station, Findhorn was a village, there was a caravan site, he lost the job and they had to live in the caravan. They started growing cabbages, which grew big, and people came, David Spangler from US, and things developed. Eileen got channelling, and the community was built around her instructions, they learned a way of working in community, then the hotel went bankrupt and in Eileen’s messages she got the inspiration to buy it, they had no money but they put in a ridiculously low offer and got it, which became their base, later they bought the caravan site, and so the community grew. They run the courses based in the hotel, then the caravan site developed into a community. Also Benjamin Creme predicting the coming of the Christ in 1981, paid for biog articles in the Newspaper. He came from the Alice Bailey tradition, who wrote over 20 books about the development of humanity, was in touch with the groups who were sitting. William says it’s a cycle of 36 years since 1981. Ellena did find it interesting, she felt that half the burden had been lifted. Benjamin Creme died recently and we went to his memorial meeting.

Mary mentioned an article in the Guardian by Dina Nayeri, about the **End Times** as a recurring theme: <https://www.theguardian.com/news/2017/aug/25/yearning-for-the-end-of-the-world> – William says it comes from a mistake in biblical translation, Israel is a 12-dimension group – US was 13 states including Pennsylvania, confusion of pronoun and proper noun, they can take their form anywhere, groups who promote Christian Israel get promoted – produces bizarre outcome. Elijah was John the Baptist, it’s a mission, not a person, none of these people physically come back, but they can engage – an emerging messiah. Like atomic physics, it’s so profound.

Janos said that Emergence is an important concept, it means revelation about change in the world, to do with the idea of Chiros, and it’s a special time when something can happen. He went to Occupy on 21st November, and thought he was in 1956 during the Hungarian Revolution, when they were witch-hunting ex-communists during the “seven days of freedom”, then they started Workers Councils – so Occupy still feels special. He went to Occupy nearly everyday, this was an example of a kind of emergence, it spun off all a whole range groups, eg Occupy Economics Working Group, still meeting Mondays and Fridays at Friends House. Chiros is a special time when something can emerge. Metanoia is when a person’s whole world-view is turned upside down – without this we will not have a new age. So we must accept that everything to happen must be imagined first, you get the idea in your head first, then you create the necessary external conditions. This has been proved by his own experience – he put himself in a situation where a miracle had to happen. It was a miracle that he came out of Hungary, the prison blew up, so 250,000 people crossed the border. The camps in Austria were all wound up in 6 months, this all happened in Oct/Nov 1956, he was in the camp in Austria until end of Dec, and set foot in Britain on 2nd January 1957 – he was shipped up to Scotland to be a miner.

Janos had been dreaming of the world in the west for ten years, mostly from French authors, had a karmic burden to fulfill when settled in England, he learned English fluently, in 1960 went to Paris for two years to learn French and he went without any resources, but had a burning desire to learn French, he always wanted to learn languages, knew he had to live and breath the language, in two

years he became fluent and began to read philosophy in French, without any resources, he slept during the day and walked the streets at night, and slowly got to know French people who offered him help. It was not possible to get a work permit, because you are already breaking the law, but he wanted a job to save money, and to live for a year without work, so that he could study. He found a German friend who knew a manager of a firm on the outskirts of Paris, he was used to a grinding machine, was good with his hands, and he learned grinding, so this is his personal example of how miracles happen: his employer said we need to legalise your situation and sent him to see someone but they didn't believe his story enough to give him a work permit, so Janos went back to the firm, and told them they don't give me a work permit, so his employer drove him to his buddy in the ministry of labour and sorted it out, what level OSD, not just manual labour but skilled labour, so he got a job for a year, so he could then live for a year without working, and did his studying, 6 hours sleep, learned the language, had a job from 3-1pm at night, got up at 8am and took the train to Paris.

Janos feels that the circular diagram is trying to capture the vision of 20 years. When he arrived in London, he met Tony Chavasse, who said you must imagine something before it will happen, they founded the Vision Network in the 1980s, about the same time as Benjamin Creme began his work. Tony said there were 12 categories (by convention), and they made it into a visual symbol, so every element means something, including the blank circle in the middle – the lines don't meet. For years, he has been working on the the holistic knowledge base with the 12-sided hexahedron. This is still waiting for a university-sized learning institution, but it will take at least 5 years to get the nuts and bolts of the new world together. He was asked if he had a billion pounds whether he would be able to make a University of Holistics – his idea is to start with 12 people one for each subject, if each of them connects with 144 people, the new age will finally break into the physical world.

William said there's a mis-understanding between 1000 and "crowd" (it doesn't have to be a precise number). Ahmet said he doesn't believe any prophecies, they never contributed to human life, they are constructed on abstract inferences. Prophecies have prevented the conscious knowledge of now. We need right now to know how we can forming the knowledge, the consciousness, the reality, what is the reality of life – all the big questions are related to this. 25 apocalyptic days – always the prophecies existed but they didn't contributed anything to the human life.

Ellena says if you are starting up there with the 144,000 if you are experiencing something coming up. Ahmet wants to know what the logic is, exploitation of the environment, he feels that prophecy doesn't have any logic to explain the function - its not accountable to other experience. Ellena feels that the many prophecies explaining the end of the world, are inconsistent, and we can't earn anything from them. Janos says if we take prophecy as an idea is this not allowable in its own right.- it has to become manifest. Ahmet say it's metaphysical manifestation. Janos says you have a vision of a building so you get material and make it real. Ahmet says you have to create the building in two dimensions, one is imagination, the other is applied - Janos says vision precedes manifestation.

Janos went on to say that we do in fact have a a prophecy of a world in which people's basic needs will be met – through **basic income**. Ahmet added that many prophecy books are published in western countries, people are unhappy and meaningless, and cunning people exploit the situation, predators, if you write about the prophecy you can sell many books. William says people believe that events are not random, there is an underlying purpose, and people want an explantation of that, eg baby in womb, the developments have a purpose, logical, not random, and asks if there is an absolute plan to explain how things will emerge. Ahmed criticises modern medicine – tasers in the hospital, colleagues understood his idea, TV audience understood said body intellect, consciousness, is very important, but the context is various important, body and mind and environment affect each other.

In relation to Ahmet's comments about medicine being exploitative, William said that his mother was taking the medicines that were affecting her mind, he stopped them one by one and she became more coherent. Ahmed added that taking the chemical things might heal in 7 days, but the natural things will heal it in 6 days, modern medicine is always using artificial methods, and stressed the importance of Consciousness.

Ellenna wanted to come back to the metanoia thing, when you have to change your mind and mentioned Renegade Ink – <https://renegadeinc.com>. Their format is that two people put different sides, eg Richard Werner (who invented QE) and David Buik, who was the analyst – he is now embarrassed about what he was saying, he used three phrases – now eating his words |- now says the banks made a wrong call. William says that Keynesian Economics has got it wrong. When you buy up bonds, the price goes up and the interest rates are dropped - <https://www.rt.com/shows/renegade-inc/> - Ellenna says that David Buik now understands it. Ahmet added that the economy is not just a technical problem, just like the body is not just a biological problem, but it uses a distinct frame.

FURTHER DISCUSSION: on Web Presence

We wondered how best to develop a web presence for the Open Research Group – currently we add our reports to Matters in the Air, which is published on <http://www.globaltable.org.uk/wp> – and is itself an offshoot of <http://www.ccmj.org> – both websites needs some rationalisation and tidying up and were only two of many different websites that were being maintained for network members..

Mary suggested that to maintain our link with the Global Table, rather than setting up a whole domain, we could set up a sub-domain org.globaltable.org for our own documents (with forwarders and/or discussion lists etc) to go with it. Janos said he would be more comfortable with an FTP type website rather than wordpress, although he had experienced difficulties with previous websites he had set up, and wordpress has the advantage of being able to input to it from several different locations – however she was willing to find a way of them working together on it, so that he had back-up.

Clearly the 12-topic Vision Network diagram was important, and we should have a page display and links for this diagram. It would also be good to have a format to incorporate the book reviews that Janos produces. Meanwhile, Mary had begun The Map (of Economic Reform), which was intended an analysis of the many different solutions to the problem: M=mitigation, A=Alternatives, P=Politics: <http://www.themap.org.uk> but if it was going to work, it needed a great deal of work to put the links in. We agreed next time to discuss ways forward.
