



Report of meeting held at School of Economic Science, 11 Mandeville Place, London W1U 3AJ
See Notes of Open Research Group Meeting held on 2nd November 2016

Present: Janos (chair), Ellena, Paul, Mary (notes), Apologies from Pete, due to transport issues. All now receiving input to Global Table, in addition to Peter Challen, via <org@globaltable.org.uk>.

The Open Research Group is finding its feet in hosting LGOT (London Global Open Table) meetings, with Pete and Janos offering presentations on fundamental issues. In the first part of this meeting, before others arrived, Janos and Mary took the opportunity of looking into getting access to his **Goodworld** website, <http://www.goodworld.lightnet.com>, which was a record of important work done by Janos over a period of years, the paramount issue being not to lose the data. We looked into possible domain names. Mary suggested a further session together on this.

Progress Report: The index page of the Global Table website <http://www.globaltable.org.uk> has been updated to reflect the new situation, and material relating to ICUK has been moved to a new wordpress site: <http://www.icuk.info>. The forward plan is to separate material relating to CCMJ (Christian Council for Monetary Justice) from the Global Table website and archive earlier CCMJ material on <http://www.ccmj.org.uk>. Simon Mouatt is taking a lead with CCMJ, and working with Moeen Yaseen on a conference on Eschatology to be held on 3rd December 2016.

US Election: Today, the news of Donald Trump's election to the presidency of the US dominated the discussion, and there was speculation about whether there was collusion with the FBI over the emails issue.

Energy from Thorium: Mary reported that at a meeting of Labour Action for Peace held on 7th November at the House of Commons - <http://www.labour-peace-action.org.uk> - she had taken the opportunity of asking John McDonnell if he was aware of Jasper Tomlinson's crucial work on thorium-based nuclear power - "he had heard of it but did not fully understand it and would welcome more information" - Paul would report this back to Jasper - i.e. to send material in layman's terms direct to John McDonnell.

Visit of Waldemar Radacz: Paul reported that he had met up with Rev Waldemar Radacz on his recent visit to London. He was now in much better health, working freelance, and planning a conference, for which Paul was checking out venues.

Funeral: Mary report that Frances Scott, activist film-maker, had died and that her funeral would be held at Golders Green Crematorium on **Tuesday 15th November 2016** at 11.15am, clashing with the Shadow-Chancellors speech on the same day from 10.30 for 11am - places booked for Ellena and John.
